- Developed by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), the TIP 50 prepares substance abuse treatment providers to ask their clients about suicidal thoughts and behaviors. It outlines 4 key steps of the “GATE” procedures (*Gather* information; *Access* supervision; *Take* responsible actions; *Extend* the actions) and provides other considerations for individuals working with those in treatment
